Theory Training

Theory Evaluation

The Theory Evaluation starts with a written exam based upon the concepts covered in the operator's reference instruction manual. These tests are graded and returned to the ones training. After that the tests are reviewed to ensure understanding and a minimum score of 70 percent is considered necessary in order to pass this part of the training.

Practical Training

The practical training is included in the hands-on part. It is here that the trainees are shown the safe operating measures, like the parking and shutdown procedures and the pre-use inspection measures. Each and every one training has the chance to operate the machinery and practice the skills they learned throughout Theory Training under the helpful eye of the program trainer in a setting that is safety controlled.

Practical Evaluation

The Practical Evaluation is where the trainees are evaluated to assure they have reached a minimum level of skill. The ones training are then assessed on an individual basis using the machine in a reasonably difficult course setting. When the assessment is finished, the ones training are de-briefed and given the opportunity to address any problems they may have about whatever part of the course. Each successful trainee's employer would be given the official documents and records soon after the program has been completed.
