Workplace training must follow a method of education and testing. There are two common ways to get forklift operator training and acquire certification. People could seek out training on their own or through the corporation with which the person is employed.

The businesses that use lift trucks would be required by local safety authorities to ensure that all operators utilizing forklifts are certified. Companies could face fines and penalties for failing to correctly train all forklift operators.

Forklift training and certification that is offered by the employers is typically facilitated by an on-site manager. Programs would normally include safety procedures, instruction on the forklift and its components and the right operation of the forklift. Testing will be performed to assess knowledge. A test of performance occurs at the end of the course. If successful, the trainee will be given a certification card.

An option to employer-provided training includes enrolling in a program at a forklift certification or industrial equipment training school. Trainees receive practical instruction on different models of forklifts. Safety procedures are a major focus of the training. A written test and driving test should be successfully completed before a forklift certification card is given. The forklift certification designation can be transferred to work carried out on a lift truck with whoever employer, that makes it convenient for those looking for a job using forklifts.
