## **Forklift Safety Training Alberta**

Forklift Safety Training Alberta - Those wanting work in companies that use forklifts have to undergo a forklift safety training program before becoming a certified operator of a forklift. There are lots of ways to go about acquiring forklift safety training. Courses are provided through company forklift certification programs, workforce training agencies, and approved video and on-line programs. The price can be minimal (or free) when provided through employment agencies or by occupational safety officers on job sites.

In most nations, lift truck operators are required to be over the age of 18 years old. Local industry bodies in cooperation with local and federal authorities could approve the forklift safety training courses. They require that operators obtain forklift certification prior to utilizing a forklift machine. A certificate is valid for four years in most areas. Companies which hire workers to drive forklift trucks could face serious liability problems if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

The untrained forklift operator is more at risk to cause injuries or damages due to incorrect utilization of the forklift. Hence, safety training courses would consist of right methods for loading and driving. Employees must pass a written exam in order to be certified. A business would normally assign a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new employees. A certified supervisor must have extensive training in forklift safety and be certified as a trainer.

People seeking gainful work as an operator of a forklift will have lots of options at their disposal to obtain the needed training and certification. Training can be available to the person through an employment agency or development agency. Individuals seeking work as forklift operators could enroll in forklift safety training courses provided by an approved trainer at an independent location. Manual laborers can find much more job opportunities if they have lift truck certification.

The internet provides another alternative for those seeking forklift safety training. Training is delivered via video and online formats. Nonetheless, certification usually requires that students write an exam and take a lift truck driving test.
