When operated by an inexperienced person, a forklift could be really dangerous. To be able to reduce the risk of accident, potential operators have to go through forklift training by a certified instructor prior to operating a forklift. All parts of forklift handling are covered in training programs. The limits and abilities of the equipment are included, along with pre-operation inspections, necessary operating procedures and ways of warning other personnel that a forklift is in the work site.

The placement of trailer tires and chock blocks would be covered in the lessons, as well as lessons on the arrangement of pallets in order to spread out the load correctly, and checks needed before driving into a trailer at a dock site. MSDS or Material Safety Data Sheet training is likewise covered in the course. Even though not directly related to the use of a forklift, MSDS training is important if an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the correct ways of handling spills, the products and their effects on people.
